Purpose

The purpose of the Boho Manor Evacuation Plan is to ensure the safety of all guests, employees, and visitors during emergencies such as fire, flood, or other hazards. This plan outlines evacuation procedures, designated routes, and assembly points.

1. Emergency Contacts

2. Emergency Alarms

5. Evacuation Responsibilities

- Conduct a headcount at the assembly point.

Employees:

- Guide guests to the nearest exit.
- Assist individuals with disabilities or special needs.
- Close doors behind you when exiting (do not lock).

6. Special Procedures

For Disabled Individuals:

- Evacuate using accessible routes.
- Employees must assist as needed and notify the Evacuation Coordinator.

For Hazardous Materials:

- Avoid carrying hazardous materials during evacuation.
- Notify emergency responders about the location and type of materials.
- 7. Post-Evacuation
- Do not re-enter the building until cleared by emergency personnel.
- The Evacuation Coordinator will ensure proper headcounts and documentation.
